Impluvium collection and storage facility

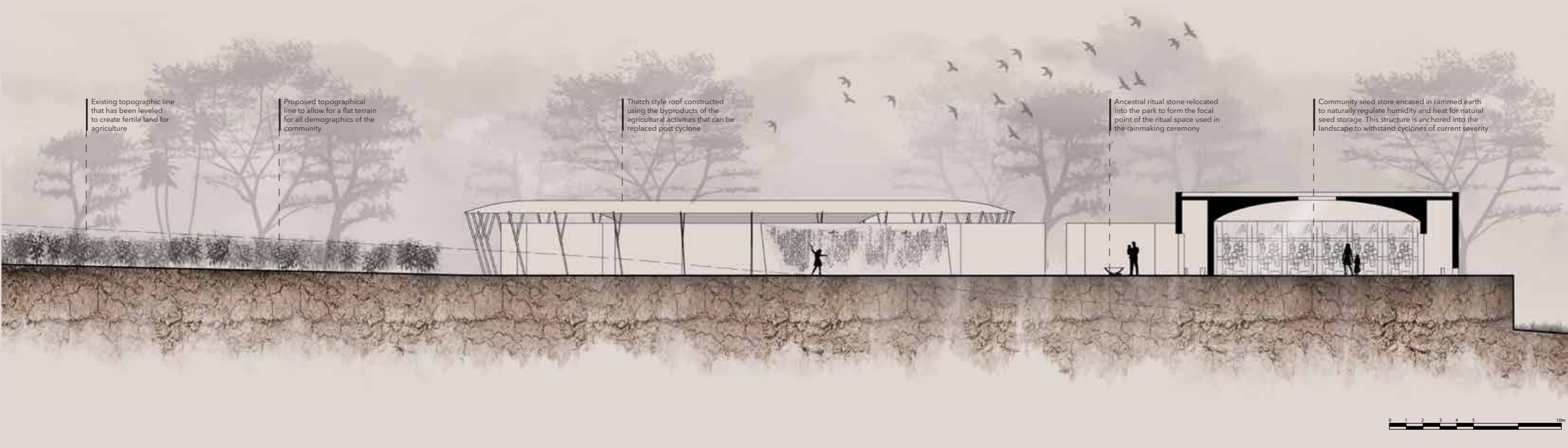
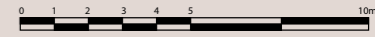
Water pump to dispense stored rain water from the impluvium

Plants that benefit from winds to spread seed naturally place in a path that forms wind vortex

Seed guardian headquarters where the women of the community can oversee the park

Central space shaded by natural shelter in the path of manipulated air that creates a cool environment for locals

Classrooms round by the community to teach growing, farming and seed storage techniques



Existing topographic line that has been leveled to create fertile land for agriculture

Proposed topographical line to allow for a flat terrain for all demographics of the community

Thatch style roof constructed using the byproducts of the agricultural activities that can be replaced post cyclone

Ancestral ritual stone relocated into the park to form the focal point of the ritual space used in the rainmaking ceremony

Community seed store encased in rammed earth to naturally regulate humidity and heat for natural seed storage. This structure is anchored into the landscape to withstand cyclones of current severity
